### **Procedure:**

- 5. Students will download the inter-faculty/programme transfer form from the University website <a href="https://www.chuka.ac.ke">www.chuka.ac.ke</a>.
- 6. Students will fill the form, upload and attach copy of KCSE result slip and submit to their current faculties.
- 7. Faculties will summarize in **Microsoft excel** the information for the two choices given. The summary will indicate the students' details, weighted cluster points the student attained for the new programme(s) and the cut-off points of the programme(s) the student intends to transfer to. Indicate qualified(Q) or not qualified(NQ) against new programme.
- 8. Summarize and submit all applications in soft copy, to the office of the Registrar (AA) not later than Tuesday 21st September, 2021.
- 9. The office of the Registrar (AA) will communicate, thereafter, to all successful and unsuccessful applicants through the University website.
- 10. Meanwhile, all students are advised to continue with the programmes they were admitted to until it is officially communicated by the office of the Registrar Academic Affairs. Successful applicants must communicate through an email to their new Faculties for the acceptance of the new changes and amendment of their records, failure to which one will not be considered to have changed to the new course.
